I hope that everyone at Daini—students and teachers—can enjoy English in and out of class. English is a useful tool, and you can only improve if you practice. I hope we can all improve together!




I hope everyone enjoyed their spring vacation! I hope you were able to recharge in order to start the new school year well.




I have been teaching here in Daini for ten years. This year is my 11th year, I teach 3 nennsei students and 2 nennsei classes. I'm really looking forward to
